

Mouth Cancer Facts

- The incidence of mouth cancer has increased by over 80% in Britain since the 1970s'.
- Cigar and pipe smokers put themselves at a great risk of developing mouth cancer than cigarette smokers.
- 86% of cases are diagnosed in those over 50 years of age.
- Mouth cancer kills 1 person every 3 hours in the UK because of late detection.
- The Human Papilloma Virus is estimated to overtake smoking as the number one cause of mouth cancer in the future.
- Mouth cancer is 2.5 times higher in those with periodontal disease.
- Mouth cancer is 60 times higher in people with 6 or more missing teeth.

- Immunosuppression
- Poor Diet
- Sunlight and sunbeds
