All registered patients under the age of 18 years are treated free or offered NHS treatment.

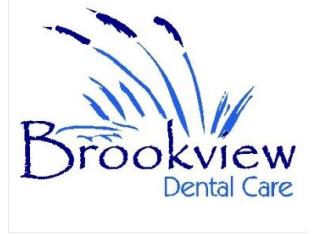
All children and adults who are receiving treatment for a medical condition, along with their carers, will always be prioritised for appointments.

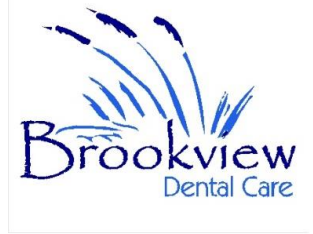
Outside of work Anum enjoys cooking, playing squash and watching football with her husband.

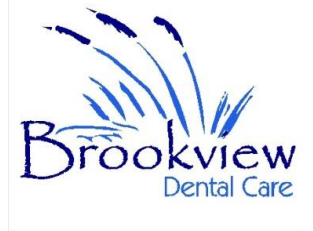
Outside of work Laura enjoys spending time with her family and friends; she especially enjoys long walks with her dog and young daughter.

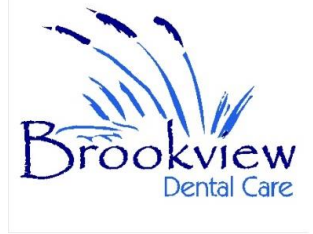
Julie is married and shares her life with her feathered Children! Yes, she has 5 parrots!

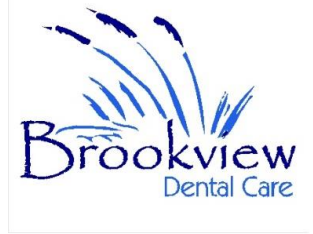
