Dental Care for Adults

DENTAL HYGIENISTS

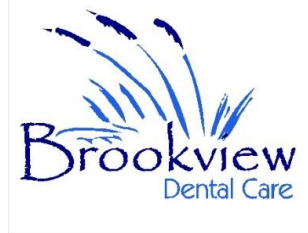
Laura Jones (Birmingham, 2016) (GDC: 218589)

Passionate about preventative dentistry and patient education, Maddy is committed to helping patients feel at ease while providing the highest standard of care in a caring gentle way.

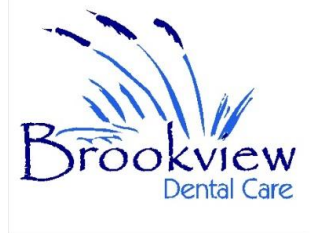
